Mission Tanzania Santa Barbara, CA St. Barbara Greek Orthodox Church Ministry and the Mission Is Possible Irvine, CA St. Paul Greek Orthodox Church Ministry have worked together to help people in the villages of Tanzania since 2009.

These ministries have provided significant medical aid, built churches, continuing sanitation & hygiene education, procured and transported new drilling equipment, and have developed 26 WELLS, already providing safe water to over 70,000 people. WITH YOUR HELP we can continue to develop wells for many more of the hundreds of villages and thousands of people still without safe drinking water.

Every day 4,000 children die of waterborne and sanitation related diseases. Over half of all childhood deaths occur in children under five years of age and are caused by UNSAFE WATER.

PROVIDING CLEAN DRINKING WATER

The goal of the Mission Tanzania water Project is to develop as many wells as possible to provide safe water close to people's homes. The women spend thousands of hours bringing water to their families. The children often drop out of school in order to help their families fetch water. Safe water means hope and life for all.

The 27th well, God willing, of many more, will be drilled right away; the team is working now and awaiting these funds so they can continue drilling.

Each well will help to sustain life for 2,500-4,000 people. The labor and material cost to develop a new well is \$5,000. This means that every \$5.00 donated is saving at least one life.
